Reference is made to your application dated October 10, 1958, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309 (a) of the Rules and Regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission to permit the commingling of the oil produced from the following described State of New Mexico oil and gas leases in an undesignated Gallup pool, to-wit:

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 309 (b) of the Rules and Regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, I hereby authorize you to commingle the production from the above-described leases from an undesignated Gallup Pool in a common tank battery.

Nothing contained herein shall be construed as authorizing the production of more than sixteen wells into a single tank battery.
