COMPANY SEEKING ADMINISTRATIVE APPROVAL FOR AN EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE RULE NO. 305 AS PERTAINING TO A CENTRAL TANK BATTERY FOR PRODUCTION FROM WELLS IN THE LOVINGTON PADDOCK POOL, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

Gentlemen:

Comes now SKELLY OIL COMPANY, a Delaware Corporation, with offices in Tulsa, Oklahoma and Hobbs, New Mexico, hereby petitioning the Secretary of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission for administrative approval for an exception to Statewide Rule No. 309 as pertaining to a central tank battery for production from wells on our State "Q", "R", "N", "Y", and Mexico "C" leases in the Lovington Paddock Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

In support of this application for administrative approval for an exception to Rule No. 309, we wish to make the following statements:

- 1. That the petitioner's State "Q" lease is the 80 acre tract confined by the S/2 SE/4 Section 36, Township 16 South, Range 36 East, which has two (2) Lovington Paddock Wells: No. 5 & 6:
- 2. That the petitioner's State "R" lease is the 240 acre tract confined by the NW/4 & E/2 SW/4 Section 36, Township 15 South, Range 36 East, which has 6 Lovington Paddock wells: No. 7, 3, 9, 10, 11, & 12.
- 3. That the petitioner's State "N" lease is the 80 server acculated by the N/2 NE/A Section 36, Township 16 Section 36, Township 16 Section 3 2 As
- to The the retitioner's State "I" lease is the 120 enter track confined by the S/2 SW/4 and the SW/4 SE/4 Section 25. Township 16 Scuth, Range 36 East, which has 3 lowington Paddock wells: No. 2, 3, & 4.
- 5. That the petitioner's Mexico "C" lease is the 40 acre tract confined by the SE/4 SE/4 Section 25, Township 16 South, Range 36 East, which has one Lovington Paddock wells No. 2.
- 6. That the above tracts are contiguous.
- 7. That all production is from the same common source of supply, namely, the Lovington Paddock Formation.

- to That no more than circles units will be produced that a occurrent tank battery and adequate facilities will be provided for accurately determining production from each well at reasonable interval.
- 9. That the above two tracts concern but a single royalty owner, namely, the State of New Mardeo and are both declicated to a common beneficiary.
- 10. That a plat of this general area showing offset ownership, gresent Lovington Faddock wells, present tank battery and flow lines and proposed flow lines, has been prepared and is accurate and complete to the best of our knowledge.
- 11. That all offset operators have been notified by registered mail with a copy of this application.
- 12. That Skelly Cil Company is the sole lease interest maker on the separate leases.

Therefore, so that under hardship will not be enforced, Exelly Oil. Company requests that the Socretary of the Commission administratively great as exception to Stateside Rule No. 309, by which oil from separate state leases may be produced into a contral tank battery.

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
