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Sunray Mid-Continent Oil Company operates two contiguous leases in Sections 29, 30 and 31, T-30-N, R-15-W, San Juan County, New Mexico.

The New Mexico Federal "P" lease contains only 40 acres consisting of the SE/4 of the NE/4 of Section 30, T-30-N, R-15-W. With the #1 well now being completed, this lease has been developed and no other wells will be drilled to the Horseshoe Canyon Fand.

The New Mexico Federal "L" lease in Section 29, and portions of Sections 30 and 31, T-30-N, R-15-W, has one well completed in the Horseshoe Canyon, also. The New Mexico Federal "L" "I was completed approximately one year ago, and has produced approximately five barrels of oil per day for the last six months. This lease is equipped with a heater treater and two-tank tank battery. We have installed a header on the New Mexico Federal "L" lease sufficient to test each well at frequent intervals.
