Humble Oil and Refining Company respectfully requests Administrative approval to commingle production from its New Mexico State "BC" and New Mexico State "BN" Leases, West Henshaw Grayburg Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

The New Mexico State "BC" Lease, comprising the SW 1/6 and the East Middle 1/6 of Sec. 2, R-30-E, T-16-S, Eddy County, New Mexico has four West Henshaw Grayburg Pool wells and one dry hole. The New Mexico State "BN" Lease, comprising the West 1/2 of the SE 1/6 and the SW 1/4 of the SE 1/6 of Sec. 2, R-30-E, T-16-S, Eddy County, New Mexico has no production at present but preparations are in progress to make application for a drilling permit for a West Henshaw Grayburg Pool well.

Since both leases have common royalty interests, the State of New Mexico, and abstracts show benefactors to be identical, it is requested that the New Mexico State "BC" and "BN" Leases be allowed to produce into common storage with each well being prorated on the basis of well tests.

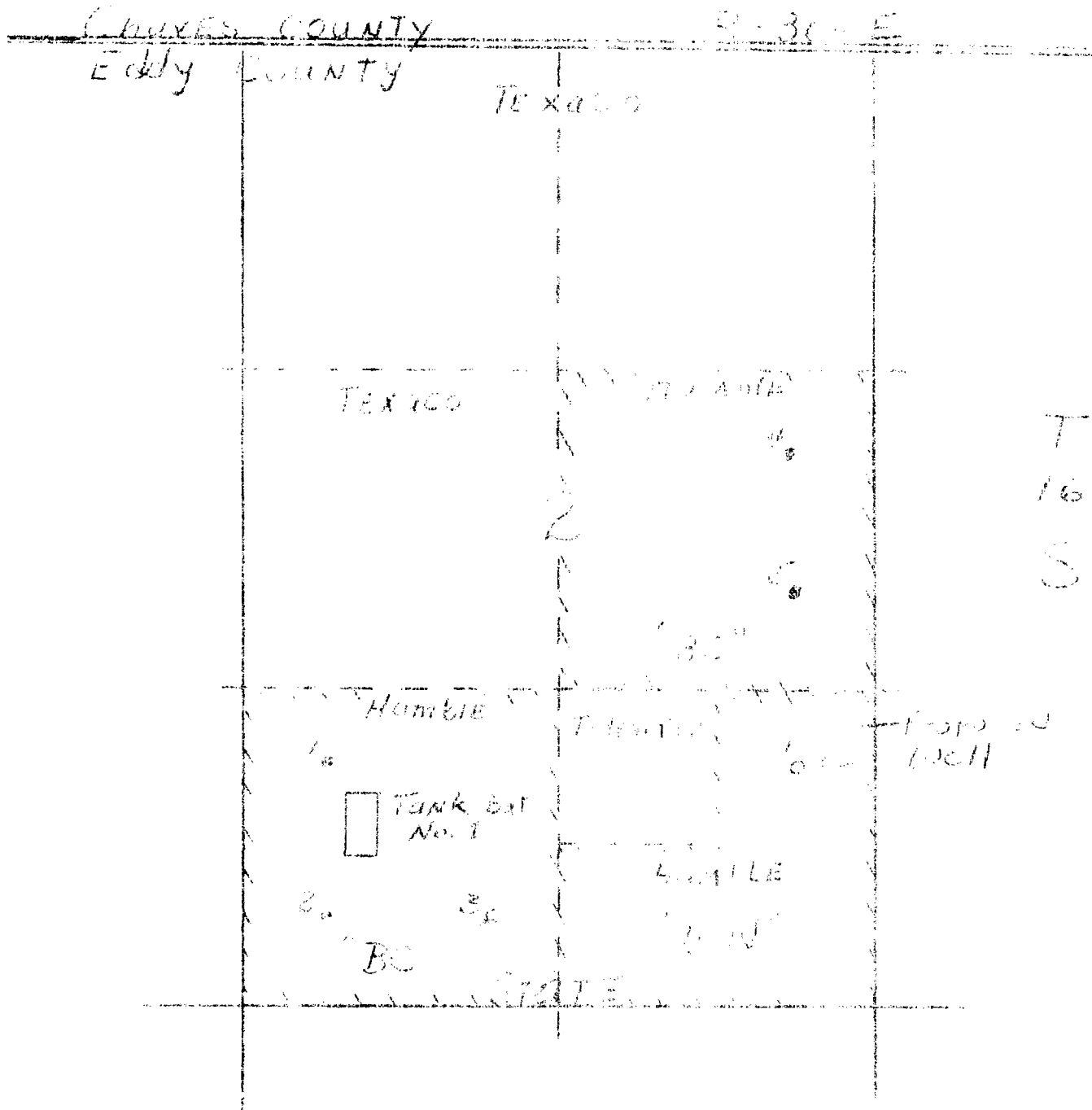

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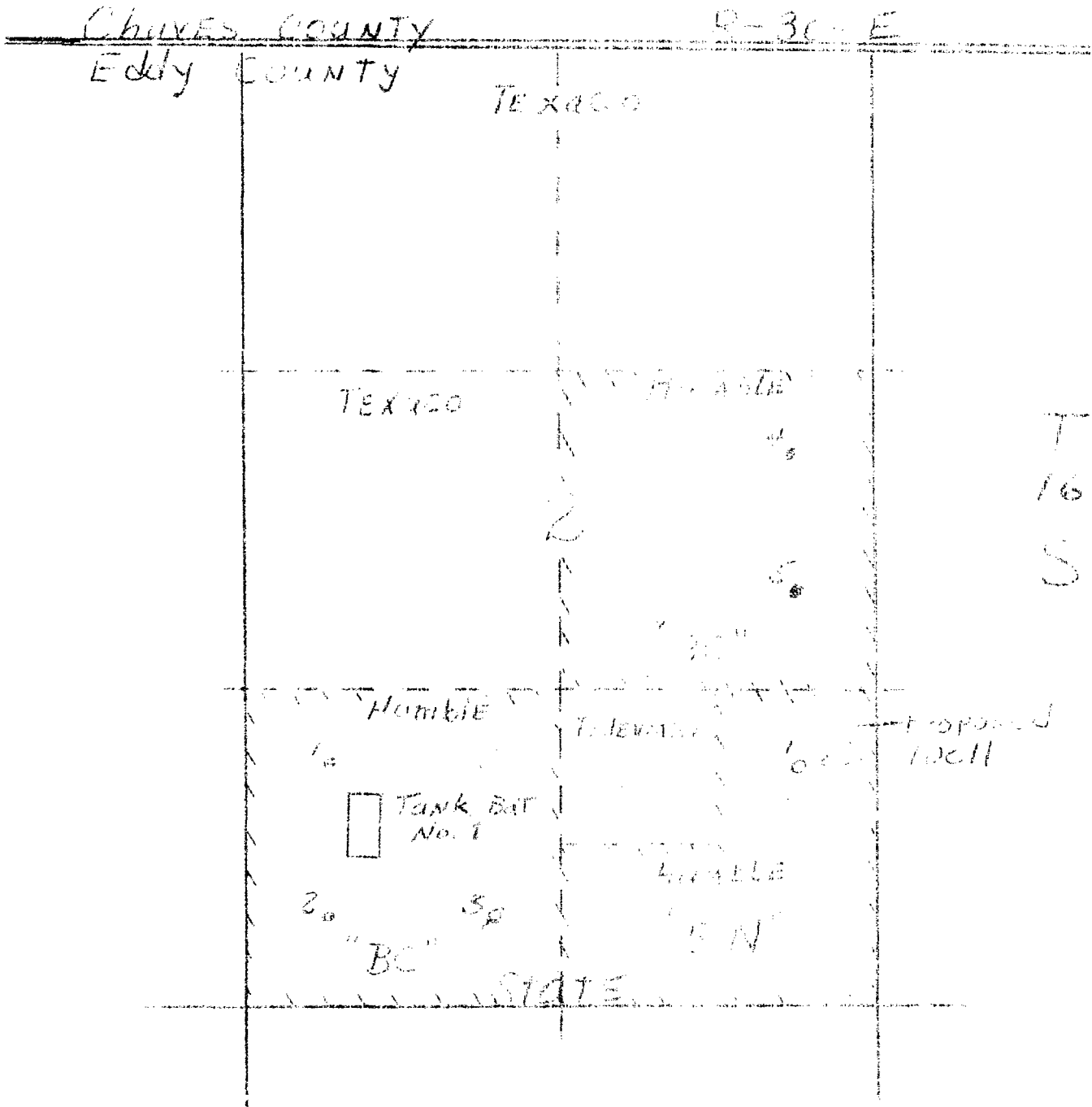
