We have discussed with your Mr. Bob Dalton, Magnolia's requirements for a proposed ACT Unit to be installed on our U. D. Sewyer Lesse described as follows:

1/2 Section 27, T-9-S, R-36-L, Les County, New Mexico

This unit will also serve our Dessie Sawyer Lasse production which is to be commingled with that of the U. D. Sawyer Lesse. The Dessie Sawyer Lesse is described as follows:

SW/4 Section 27, T-9-8, R-36-E, Les County, New Mexico

In accordance with Mr. Delton's request, we are staching the following information for your consideration:

- 1. Equipment Specifications
- 2. Schematic Drawing of ACT Unit
- 3. Skid Operating Sequences
- 4. Protective or Feil Safe Features

We understand that a 12 hour weathering period must be maintained, also that we may produce and run from the same 500 barrel tank, provided the fill line extends no further than 18" into the tank. The PD meter will operate in a range of 30% to 80% of its opposity, and 30 psig should be the maximum line pressure condition. We are to furnish the meter prover. However, salibration of this vessel plus periodic meter provings will be a service of your company, with assistance from our personnel.
