Pan American Petroleum Corporation hereby respectfully requests and submits application for Administrative Approval for the commingling of production from separate leases as follows:

State "EB" No. 1, Unit M, Section 36, T-17-S, R-27-E, NMPM,  
Eddy County, New Mexico

State "CM" No. 1, Unit L, Section 36, T-17-S, R-27-E, NMPM,  
Lea County, New Mexico

In support of our request for exception to Rule 309-A to permit the commingling of production from two separate leases into a common tank battery without notice and hearing, the following is submitted:

1. Plats of the leases, showing thereon the wells and the formation in which they are completed.
  2. Schematic diagram of the commingling facility located in Unit M, Section 36, T-17-S, R-27-E, Eddy County, New Mexico.
  3. Production is from common source of supply, Abo Formation Empire Abo Field.
  4. All parties owning an interest in the leases and the purchaser of the commingled production have been notified by certified mail of our intention to commingle the production from these leases.
  5. The production will be separately measured utilizing A. O. Smith T-6 temperature compensated meters equipped with samplers which will be proved monthly by master meter.

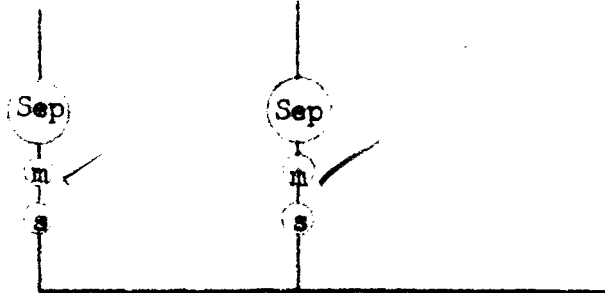
