We would appreciate it very much, if you would send us a diagram of the equipment and a complete plat of pipelines, etc.

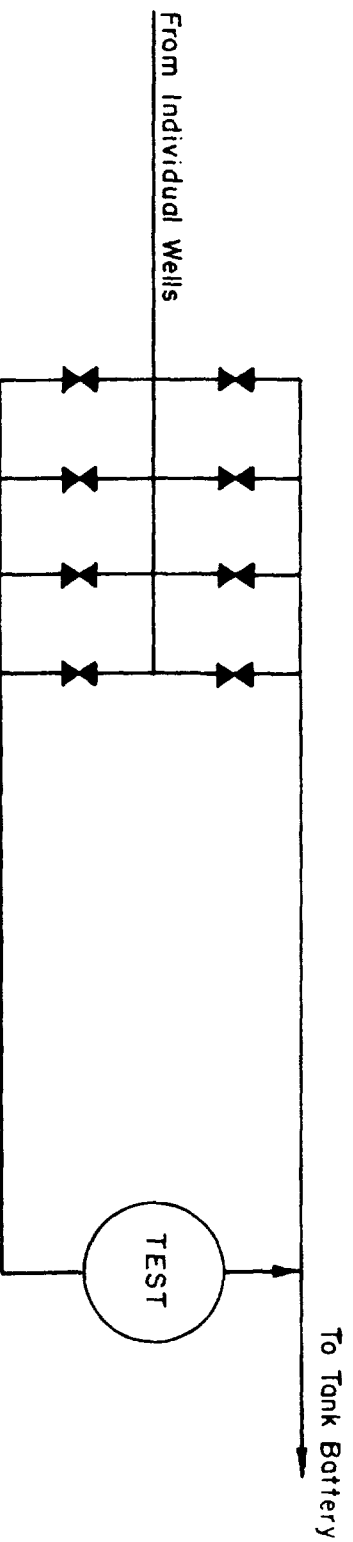

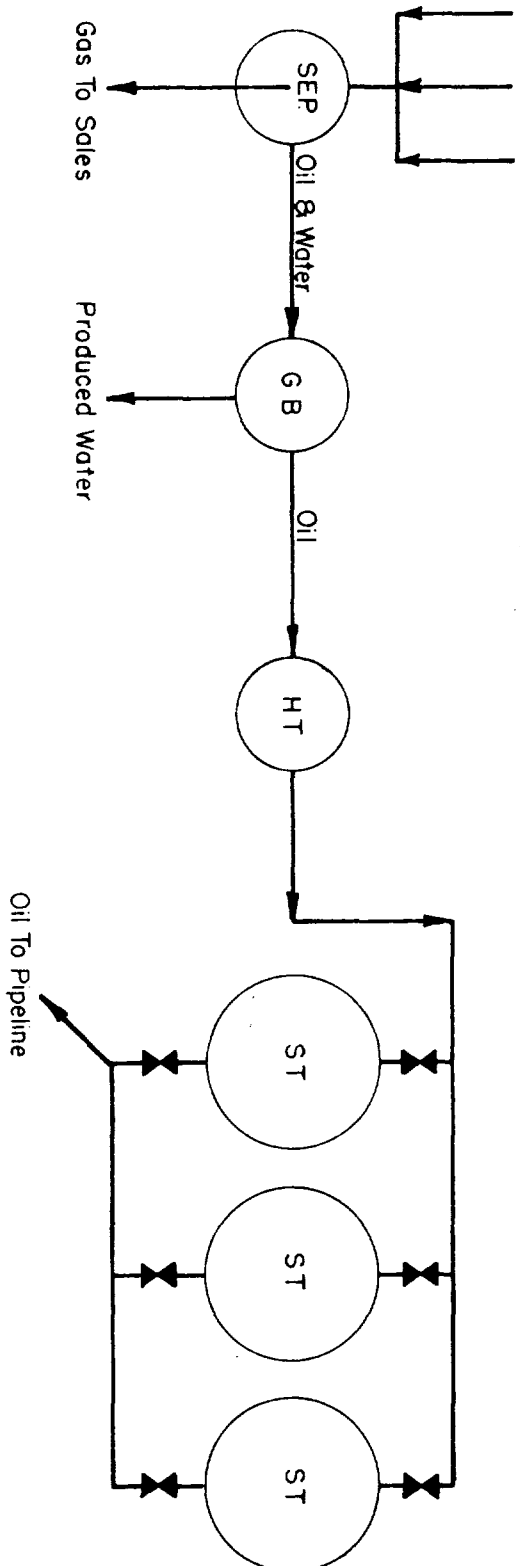
