Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated November 9, 1962, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of oil produced from your Santa Fe Pacific B, C, D, E, and G Leases comprising the NW/4 of Section 26, the SW/4 of Section 26, the SE/4 of Section 22, the SW/4 of Section 23, and the NW/4 of Section 35, respectively, all in Township 9 South, Range 36 East, Crossroads-Devonian Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, allocating the production to each lease on the basis of periodic well tests.

It is our understanding that each of the leases has a common working interest and royalty interest under Lease No. NM-1223.

Under the authority granted me pursuant to Rule 309-B, you are hereby authorized to commingle the above-described production as proposed, subject to the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."
