**Administrative Order CTB-98**

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated November 14, 1962 for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of oil produced from the South Vacuum (Bone Springs) Pool, underlying your State Lea 403 lease and your State Lea 405 lease comprising the W/2 Section 22 and the NW/4 of Section 27 respectively Township 18 South, Range 35 East, Lea County, New Mexico. It is understood that the ownership of the two leases is common throughout. Therefore you propose to commingle and allocate production on the basis of monthly well tests.

Under the authority granted me pursuant to Rule 309-D, you are hereby authorized to commingle the above described production as proposed, subject to the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."
