AMENDMENT

Administrative Order CTB-118

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated April 2, 1965, wherein you request an amendment to Administrative Order CTB-118 to permit the commingling of Empire Abo production from your Chalk Bluff Draw Well No. 3-P located in the SE/4 NE/4 of Section 8, Township 18 South, Range 27 East, with other Empire Abo production at your Empire Abo Storage System III located in the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 3, Township 18 South, Range 27 East.

It is our understanding that production from each lease is metered and sampled separately prior to commingling and that the production from the subject Well No. 3 would likewise be metered and sampled.

Administrative Order CTB-118 is hereby amended to permit the inclusion of the aforesaid Chalk Bluff Draw Well No. 3-P in the commingling installation as proposed, subject to the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for temperature-compensated meters, samplers, and non-reset counters on the meters.
