AMENDMENT

Administrative Order CTB-129

Reference is made to your letter of March 11, 1965, wherein you request an amendment to Administrative Order CTB-129, entered October 16, 1964, as amended January 13, 1965, which authorizes the commingling of Lusk-Strawn production on your USA-Continental Unit, USA-Continental "A" Unit and your USA-Hudson Lease in Sections 5 and 6, Township 19 South, Range 32 East, Lea County, New Mexico. It is our understanding that you now wish to include in the commingling installation your USA-Trigg Lease comprising the SW/4 of Section 8, Township 19 South, Range 32 East and your USA-Moleen Lease comprising the SE/4 of Section 31, Township 18 South, Range 32 East, Lea County, New Mexico.

Administrative Order CTB-129 is hereby amended to include the aforesaid USA-Trigg and USA-Moleen Leases, provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," particularly Section III, Commingling Between Leases.
