

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
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

Dear Mr. Sperling:

We have reviewed the proposal of Kern County Land Company to commingle production from Wells 1,2, 3, and 4 in the East Saunders Permo-Penn Pool, which are located in Sections 17 and 20, Township 7 South, Range 34 East, as indicated on your Exhibit "A" plat which you submitted to the Oil Conservation Commission in connection with that proposal. It is our understanding that Wells 1, 2 and 3 are already being commingled and that your proposal is to add the production from Well No. 4, which is on Common School Lands. Although the production from two beneficiaries, Portales Normal and Common Schools, is now being commingled, it is our understanding that you propose to separately meter the production from Well No. 4 to insure the separate allocation of royalty to the Common School beneficiary.

As your proposal was outlined on May 9, 1966, by letter to the Oil Conservation Commission, there appears to be no objection that the Commissioner of Public Lands would make in regard to your commingling application.

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


Dear Mr. Nutter:

Following our conference in Santa Fe with Mrs. Rhea, I advised the representatives of my client, Kern County Land Company, of the results of our conference and suggested that they proceed with the installation of meters. I understand that Mr. Eden of the Kern County Land Company office in Midland has discussed the matter with you. This letter is to advise you that they are proceeding with the installation of the two meters, one to measure the production from the No. 4 Well and one to measure the production from the 1, 2 and 3 Wells, which is presently being commingled. The cost of the meter installation and other necessary facilities in connection therewith exceeds considerably my, and I believe your, estimate of the cost. Apparently, it will run somewhere in the neighborhood of \$6,000.00. When the installation has been completed, you will be advised.

Dear Mr. Nutter:

You will recall our conversation concerning the desire of Kern County Land Company to commingle production from the captioned well with other wells in this Field presently subject to Administrative Order CTB-84 issued June 21, 1962. At the time of our conversation, I advised you that you would be informed when the Office of the Commissioner of Public Lands had approved Communitization Agreement covering acreage dedicated to this I further advised you that following communitization well. approval, I would furnish you with a Plat showing the location of the respective wells, including the captioned well, and the location of the Central Tank Battery and a diagram of the commingling facilities. Accordingly, I enclose herewith such a Plat and diagram.

The Completion Reports, Forms C-104 and C-105, have been filed with the Commission. In rechecking Order CTB-84, it would appear that the East Half of Section 17 is included within the Order. We would appreciate this being confirmed in view of the completion of the Number 4 Well.

As is indicated on the Plat, the royalty ownership is common under the Northeast Quarter of Section 17.
