AMENDMENT

Administrative Order CTB-162

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter dated December 12, 1966, wherein you request authority to include your Wasley Lease and your Crosby "D" Lease in the Cato Storage System No. I authorized by Administrative Order CTB-162 dated September 13, 1966, as amended October 18, 1966, and December 15, 1966.

It is our understanding that the Wasley production will be separately metered prior to commingling and that the Crosby "D" production is of identical ownership to the Crosby "B" and Crosby "C" production and will therefore be commingled with the latter production without separate metering, but that all Crosby production is metered prior to commingling with that from any other lease.

Administrative Order CTB-162 is hereby amended to permit the commingling of the above leases in the manner proposed, subject to the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters. Please notify the Hobbs District Office of the Commission at such time as the installation is complete in order that an inspection may be made of the installation.
