Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Inbe-Permo Pennsylvanian production from your State "D" Lease and from your State "D" Com Well No. 5, all in Section 8, Township 11 South, Range 34 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from the State "D" Com Well No. 5.

By the authority granted me pursuant to Rule 309-B, Southern Minerals Corporation is hereby authorized to commingle the above-described production as proposed, subject to the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters. Please notify the Hobbs District Office of the Commission at such time as this installation is complete in order that an inspection may be made thereof.

It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.
