
Gentlemen:

In accordance with Rule 309-B I hereby apply for exception to Rule 309-A to permit the commingling of production from my Citgo State Well No. 4 in the tank battery presently serving Citgo State Wells No. 2 and 3. All of the production is from a common reservoir, being the P₂ Zone of the San Andres Formation at a depth of approximately 2600'.

I propose to install a separating device and meter near the wellhead of the Well No. 4, and will make monthly reports to the purchaser of actual production from this well for a division of runs.

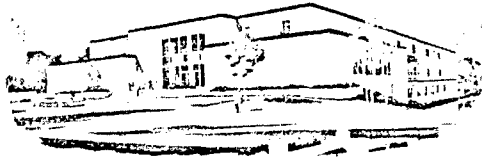

Regarding your request to commingle products from the captioned leases, we have no objection to this request. Therefore, the Commissioner of Public Lands, by the authority vested in him, hereby grants approval to commingle products from Wells Nos. 2, 3 and 4 on State of New Mexico Oil and Gas Leases No. OG-4681 and K-2803, Citgo State Lease.

This approval is granted with the understanding that there will be separate metering on the one well on Lease K-2803.

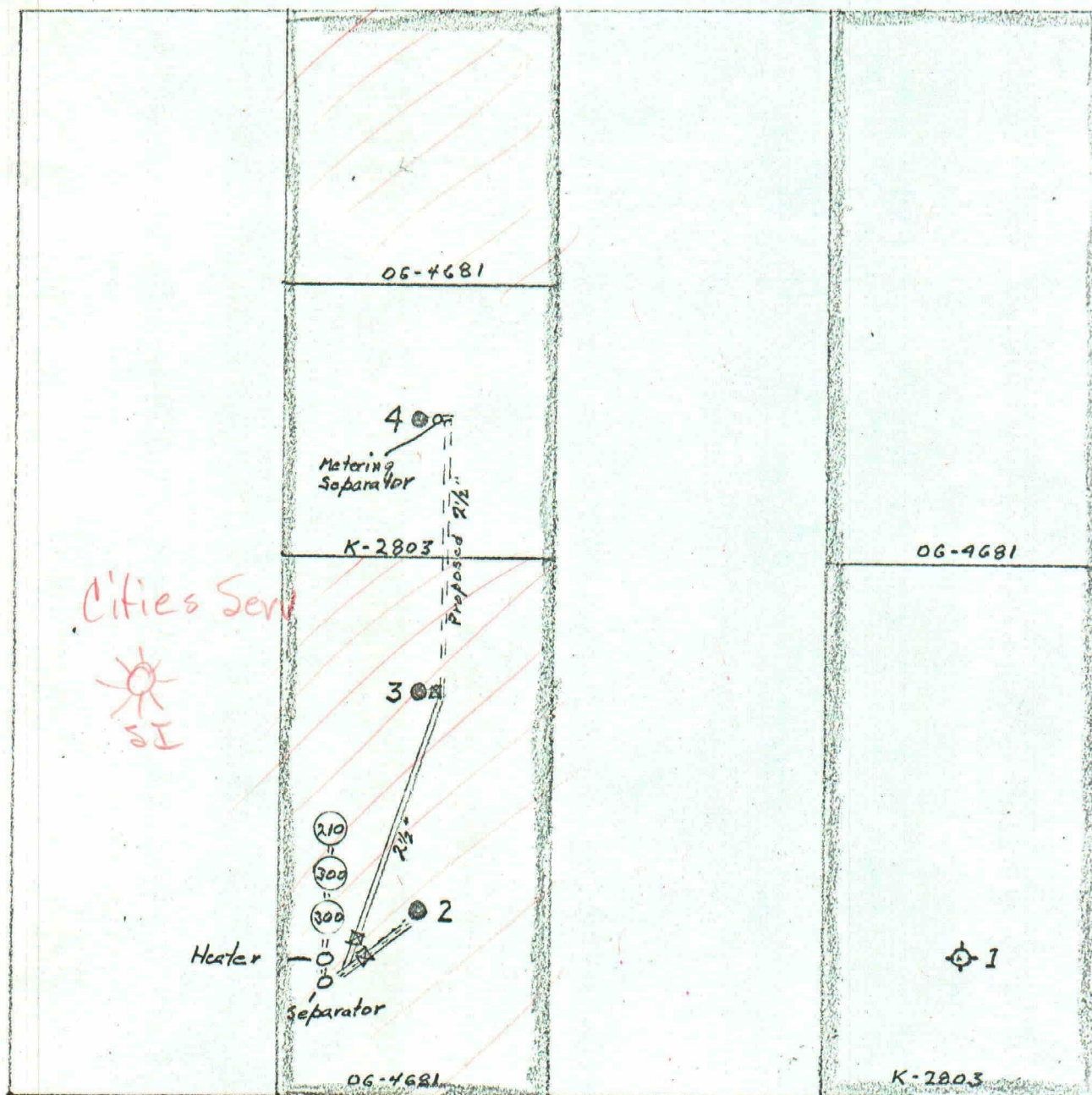
