The above named company is hereby authorized to commingle Linda San Andres (38990) Pool production from the following leases:

Lease: Johnson 'IL' Well No.1  
Description: SW/4 SE/4 of Section 30, and;

Lease: Federal 'HJ' Well Nos.2, 9 and 10 (Federal Lease No.NM-02357)  
Description: N/2 NE/4 and NE/4 SE/4 of Section 31,

both located Township 6 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Chaves County, New Mexico.


Production shall be allocated to each lease by separately metering the production from each lease prior to commingling.

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 303 of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

REMARKS: The commingled production shall be stored in the Federal 'HJ' tank battery facility located in Unit Letter 'A', Section 31, Township 6 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Chaves County, New Mexico.

FURTHER: The operator shall notify the Artesia district office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling process.
