The above named company is hereby authorized to commingle West Bitter Lakes San Andres (6000) Pool production from the following leases:

Lease: Cannon Fee Well Nos.1, 2Y and 3
Description: E/2 SE/4, and,

Lease: Cannon Well Nos.1 and 2
Description: E/2 NE/4,

all in Section 17, Township 10 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Chaves County, New Mexico.


Production shall be allocated to each lease by well tests. This method is authorized only so long as all commingled production is of identical ownership including working interest, royalty interest, and overriding royalty interest.

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 303 of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

REMARKS: The commingled production shall be stored in the Cannon tank battery facility located in Unit Letter 'A' of Section 17, Township 10 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Chaves County, New Mexico.

FURTHER: The operator shall notify the Artesia district office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling process.
