Enclosed you will find the application that I sent you earlier that you returned. I have included the information on the mineral owners and have notified them accordingly.

Each well has a separation facility that separates and stores oil and water. The only hydrocarbon sent down the line is gas. The gas is metered at each well before it goes into El Paso's meter. The total sales for each well is allocated by taking the integrated chart volumes on each well and dividing by the total of the two wells integrated volumes. This percentage is then multiplied by the total gas sales volume received from El Paso.




