Amendment
Administrative Order PC-82

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of December 23, 1964, wherein you advise that certain wells completed in the Blinebry zone on Texaco's G. L. Erwin "a" Lease, comprising the SW/4 of Section 35, Township 24 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, are now capable of top allowable production following rework.

Administrative Order PC-82, entered May 11, 1962, as amended July 20, 1962, and October 9, 1964, authorizes the commingling of Tubb-Drinkard, Devonian, and Blinebry production on said lease without separate measurement due to the marginal nature of all zones.

Administrative Order PC-82 is hereby amended to provide that the Blinebry on said lease shall be separately metered prior to commingling and the subtraction method used for determining the Tubb-Drinkard and the Devonian production.
