Dear Sirs:

The Wiser Oil Company, as operator of the referenced leases, hereby requests permission to commingle all oil production from same. Per Commingling Order PLC-131, dated May 6, 1997, we already have authorization to commingle Penrose Skelly Grayburg (Oil - 50350) and Drinkard (Oil - 19190) production from the Rinewalt "A" #1 and Rinewalt #1.

We would like to commingle the production from the Rinewalt B #1 into the same tank battery. It is not economical to maintain separate facilities for these wells. Combining the facilities will promote fiscally sound operation and extend the life of the wells.

Production will be allocated based on well tests. Gravity ranges from 34.1 to 35.7 and is under one oil contract. All working and revenue interests are common between the three leases.
