

Conoco, Inc. proposes to produce the DM Warren #137 into the SEMU Strawn battery located in Section 25, T20S, R37E, Unit Letter G, Lea County, New Mexico. The DM Warren, Well #137 will have its own separator and test system. The production separator will have a positive displacement meter that will measure the oil continuously. The production will be allocated based upon well test. When testing the well, the oil and gas will be measured and routed back into the production separator so that all of the lease's production is measured. The gas will be measured with an orifice meter. The gas will then be allocated based upon the gas sales meter for the SEMU Strawn battery.

The gravity of the Strawn completions going into the SEMU Strawn battery is 37 degrees API – sweet crude. The possible Tubb Drinkard completion in the DM Warren #137 should have a gravity of 37.6, sweet crude.

The royalty and working interest owners are identical for the Strawn and the Tubb zones.


