The above-named company is hereby authorized to commingle Wildcat-Drinkard Oil and North Monument-Drinkard Gas Pool production from the following leases:

Lease:	Monument 13 State Well No. 27

Lease:	Monument 12 State Well No. 10
Description:	SW/4 SW/4 of Section 12, Township 19 South, Range 36 East, NMPM,
Lease:	Monument 13 State Well No. 29
Description:	NW/4 SW/4 of Section 13, Township 19 South, Range 36 East, NMPM,

located in Lea County, New Mexico.

Production shall be allocated to each lease by separately metering the production from each lease prior to commingling.

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 309-B of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

REMARKS: The commingled production shall be stored and measured at the Monument Drinkard tank battery facility located in the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 12. Township 19 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.


FURTHER: The operator shall notify the Hobbs district office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling process.
