- 1. That application has been filed in due form.
- 2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
- 3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-972-B.
- 4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection wells under the terms of Order R-972-B.
- 5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
 - 6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant Graridge Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Queen formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery:
