Under the provisions of Order No. R-1191, Caulkins Oil Company has made application to the Commission on October 9, 1958, for permission to expand its South Blanco Tocito Pool Pressure Maintenance Project in the South Blanco Tocito Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 5th day of November, 1958, the Secretary-Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed in due form.
- 2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
- 3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-1191.
- 4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-1191.
- 5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
 - 6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Caulkins Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Tocito formation through the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Caulkins Oil Company Well T-109, located in the SW/4 SW/4, Section 3, Township 26 North, Range 6 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico

Done at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year hereinabove designated.
