ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 701, Ryder Scott Company has made application to the Commission on November 16, 1961, for permission to expand its Stanton-Turkey Track Water Flood Project in the Turkey Track Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 1st day of December, 1961, the Secretary-Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed in due form.
- 2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
- 3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Rule 701.
- 4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Rule 701.
- 5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
 - 6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Ryder Scott Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Queen formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Brainard Well No. 5 W located 1325 feet from the west line and 1325 feet from the South line and Brainard Well No. 6 W located 2645 feet from the West line and 1325 feet from the South line - both in Section 34, Township 18 South, Range 29 East, NMPM.
