ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

That the applicant, Rock Island Oil & Refining Company, Inc., be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Yates formation through the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:
