# ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 701, Ambassador Oil Corporation has made application to the Commission on June 22, 1965, for permission to expand its Grayburg-Jackson Unit Water Flood Project in the Grayburg-Jackson Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 7th day of July, 1965, the Secretary-Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed in due form.
- That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
- 3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Rule 701.
- 4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Rule 701.
- 5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
  - That the application should be approved.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Ambassador Oil Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Grayburg formation through the following-described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Unit Well No. 6A-1 located in the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 26, Township 17 South, Range 30 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.
