Gentlemen:

Tidewater Oil Company respectfully requests administrative approval to inject water in its East Eumont Unit Well No. 915, for the purpose of water flooding in the Yates, Seven Rivers and Queen formations of the Eumont Pool, in accordance with Rule 701-E of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Rules and Regulations.

In support of this application, Tidewater wishes to state the following:

1. Tidewater Oil Company is operator of the East Eumont Unit waterflood project which was approved by the NMOCC on May 4, 1965 by Order No. R-2901. This order approved 69 injection wells.

2. Tidewater's EEU #915, formerly Cities Service Oil Company's State "AR" Well No. 1, came into the East Eumont Unit on January 1, 1966.

3. Tidewater's EEU #915 is on pattern of the injection system of the EEU water flood project. The addition of this injection well to the EEU will result in a more thorough and efficient sweep in the immediate area.

4. Attached is a plat showing the location of the proposed injection well and the entire East Eumont Unit.

5. Attached is a diagrammatic sketch of the proposed injection well showing all pertinent data.

6. Tidewater proposes to inject water into the Queen formation. Perforations in Well No. 915 are at 3746' to 3812'. Derrick floor elevation is 3613'. 7. Source water will be from the EEU water Well No. 1 producing salt water from the San Andres formation. This supply well has been approved by the State Engineer.

8. A copy of this application with all attachments has been sent to the State Engineer's Office in Santa Fe.


