ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 701, Archie M. Speir, has made application to the Commission on January 8, 1968, for permission to expand his South Red Lake Grayburg Unit Water Flood Project in the Red Lake Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 23rd day of January, 1968, the Secretary-Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed in due form.
- 2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
- 3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Rule 701.
- 4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Rule 701.
- 5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
 - 6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Archie M. Speir, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Grayburg formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

SRLG Unit Well No. 41 located in Unit P of Section 36, and

SRLG Unit Well No. 42 located in Unit N of Section 36, both in Township 17 South, Range 27 East, NMPM
