Dear Mr. Porter:

Burwinkle & Scanlon, operators of the oil and gas lease in Section 28, 20N, 9W, N.M.P.M., McKinley County, New Mexico, requested and received permission to inaugurate a water flood program in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 28 under Order R-3346. Section 28 is in the confines of the Chaco Wash-Mesa Verde Oil Pool and the oil pool rules for this Chaco Wash-Mesa Verde Oil Pool require each well to be 165 feet from the boundary of the quarter-quarter section line and no nearer than 330 feet to the nearest well capable of producing from the same source of supply. In our application for this water flood project, we stated we would drill 5 wells, Nos. 1 through 5, all in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28, and would produce from Wells 1, 2, 3, and 4 and would inject water into Well #5. See Plate 2, attached, for these well locations. Well #5 is located approximately 60 feet away from two plugged and abandoned wells drilled to this same source of supply. In our initial attempt to inject water into Well #5, we were unable to obtain any appreciable injection pressure and the formation was taking water at zero pressure at all volumes. We have arrived at the conclusion that there is channeling from Well #5 into one of the two abandoned wells and that Well #5 will be unsuitable for use as an injection well for this project. We have drilled another well, #8, see Plate 2, which well is located 330 feet from the north line and 1,980 feet from the west line of Section 28.

Based on the above information, we hereby make the following requests:

1. That we be permitted to inject water into Well #8.
2. That an exception be granted to permit us to produce Well #5 even though it does not conform to the spacing rules for producing wells as set out for the Chaco Wash-Mesa Verde Oil Pool. The granting of this request will then allow us to proceed with the 5-spot spacing on the balance of the acreage.

Copies of this request are being mailed to the offset lessees (See Plate 1) with the request that they waive any objection to these changes and additions by sending such waiver directly to your office in Santa Fe, New Mexico.

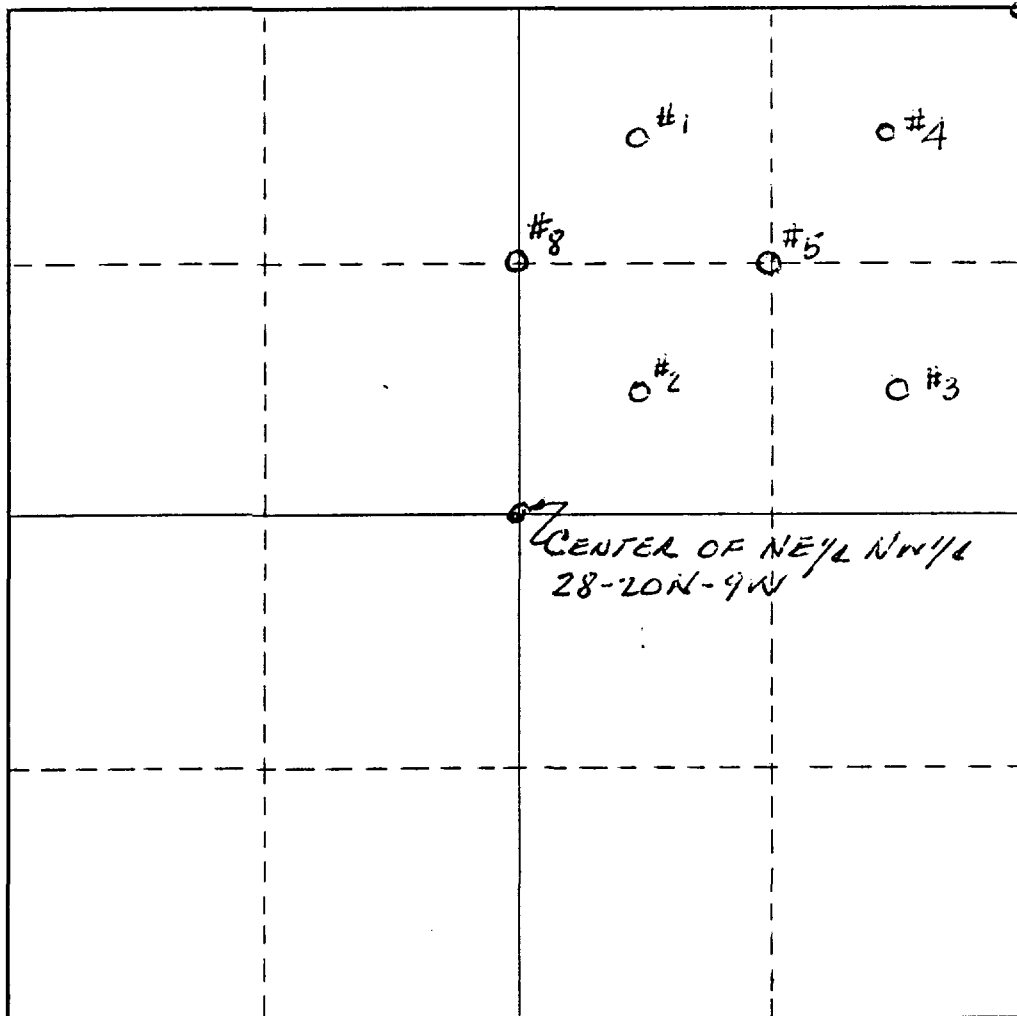

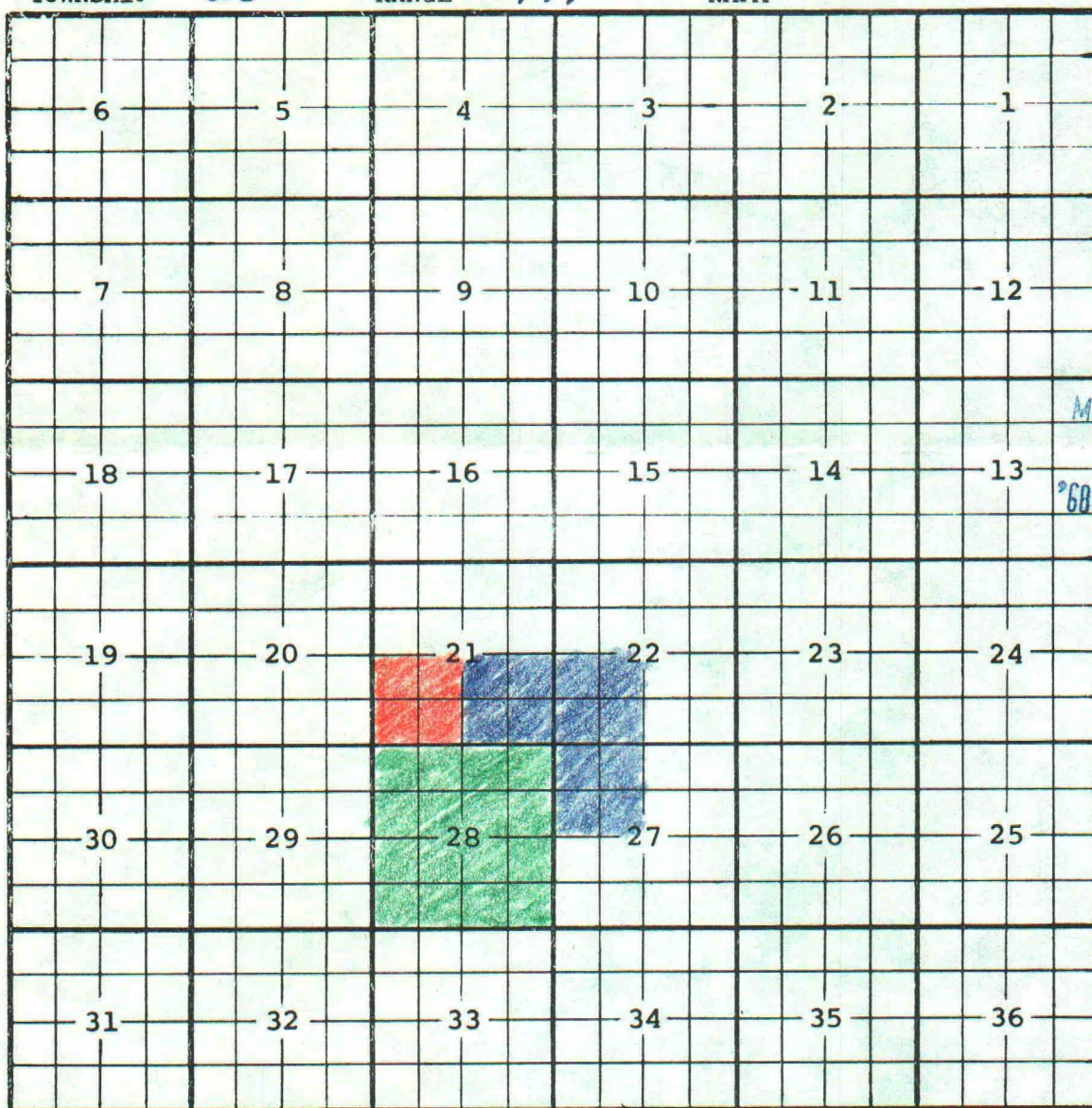
