ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-2403, Continental Oil Company has made application to the Commission on February 6, 1969, for permission to expand its MCA Unit Water Flood Project in the Maljamar Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 21st day of February, 1969, the Secretary-Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed in due form.
- 2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
- 3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-2403.
- 4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-2403.
- 5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
 - 6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Continental Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Grayburg-San Andres formations through the following-described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Gulf-State "E" Well No. 3 located in Unit L of Section 16,

Hudson-Federal Well No. 1, located in Unit L of Section 15,

both in Township 17 South, Range 32 East, NMPM.

<u>PROVIDED HOWEVER</u>, That the applicant shall inject water through tubing with packers set just above the injection intervals in said wells.
