ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-3704, Amerada Hess Corporation has made application to the Commission on August 27, 1969, for permission to expand its Langlie Mattix Woolworth Unit Water Flood Project in the Langlie-Mattix Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 11th day of September, 1969, the Secretary-Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed in due form.
- 2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
- 3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-3704.
- 4. That the Proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-3704.
- 5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
 - 6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Amerada Hess Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Queen formation through the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

L.M.W.U. Well No. 204 located in Unit M of Section 28, Township 24 South, Range 37 East, NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That the applicant shall inject water through tubing with a packer set at approximately 3450 feet.
