## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 701, Atlantic Richfield Company has made application to the Commission on September 22, 1969, for permission to expand its Shugart Panco Water Flood Project in the Shugart Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 7th day of October, 1969, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.

2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.

3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Rule 701.

4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Rule 701.

5. That the proposed expansion of the abovereferenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Atlantic Richfield Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Queen formation through the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

> Panco Federal Well No. 4 to be drilled 2310 feet FNL and 2310 feet FWL of Section 23, Township 18 South, Range 31 East, NMPM.

**PROVIDED HOWEVER**, That the applicant shall inject water through tubing with a packer set at approximately 3345 feet in said well.

DONE at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year hereinabove designated.
