ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-3214, Skelly Oil Company has made application to the Commission on December 2, 1969, for permission to expand its Grayburg-Jackson Skelly Unit Water Flood Project in the Grayburg-Jackson Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 17th day of December, 1969, the Secretary-Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed in due form.
- 2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
- 3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-3214.
- 4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-3214.
- 5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
 - 6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Skelly Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Grayburg-San Andres formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Unit Well No. 79 located in Unit N of Section 23 and Unit Well No. 81 located in Unit P of Section 23 both in Township 17 South, Range 31 East, NMPM.
