ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 701, Texaco Inc. has made application to the Commission on May 11, 1973, for permission to expand its Cotton Draw Water Flood Project in the Paduca-Delaware Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 15th day of May, 1973, the Secretary-Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed in due form.
- 2. That satisfactory information has been provided that no offset operators are affected by conversion of the subject well
- 3. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Rule 701.
- 4. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
 - 5. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Texaco Inc., be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Delaware formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Unit Well No. 47 located in Unit C of Section 28, Township 25 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, and Well No. 29 located in Unit K, Section 21, Township 25 South, Range 32 East, Lea County, New Mexico.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That the applicant shall inject water through tubing with a packer set at approximately 4570 feet.
