ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Orders No. R-2403 and R-2403-A, Continental Oil Company has made application to the Commission on September 23, 1974, for permission to expand its MCA Unit Area Water Flood Project in the Maljamar Grayburg-San Andres Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 27th day of September, 1974, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that the offset operator has been duly notified of the application;
3. That waiver of objection has been received from such offset operator;
4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Orders No. R-2403 and R-2403-A.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Continental Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Grayburg-San Andres formation through the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

MCA Unit Well No. 56 located in Unit
L, Section 19, Township 17 South,
Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County,
New Mexico.
