# ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-4290, McClellan Oil Corporation has made application to the Commission on August 20, 1975, for permission to expand its Sulimar-Queen Unit Water Flood Project in the Sulimar-Queen Pool, Chaves County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 29th day of August, 1975, the Secretary-Director finds:

- That application has been filed in due form.
- 2. That satisfactory information has been provided that there are no other offset operators.
- 3. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-4290.
- 4. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
