## Gentlemen:

DEPCO, Inc., Camp Flood was approved in September, 1970, by R-4027. DEPCO, Inc. requests administration approval to convert and inject water into State 647 wells #205, #85, #84, and #89 in the Camp Flood. The location of these wells is marked in red on the attached plat. These wells are located in Section 33 and Section 27, Township 18 South, Range 28 East, Eddy County, New Mexico. The subject wells are producing wells, therefore, approval to convert them will be necessary. The approval to create more injectors is sought in order to complete a more efficient injection pattern.

Enclosed for your information are portions of the logs over the zones of interest for the proposed injection wells. Also, diagrammatic sketches for these wells are enclosed. Mr. Jim Kapteina April 5, 1976 Page 2

Injection will be into the San Andres pay at an approximate depth of 2,700'. Initial injection rates will be approximately 300 BWPD per well. The injection water will be fresh water from the city of Carlsbad and salt water produced from the Camp Flood.

The attached plat shows the location of the present injection wells.




Camp Flood

Cummulative to 1-1-76




