## Dear Mr. Tennison:

Reference is made to your request dated July 6, 1993 to increase the surface injection pressure on the above-referenced well. This request is based on a step rate tests conducted on June 26, 1993. The results of the test have been reviewed by my staff and we feel an increase in injection pressure on this well is justified at this time.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following well:

Well and Location	Maximum Injection Surface Pressure
Malaga Unit Well No. 12-2 990' FSL - 330' FWL Unit M, Section 7, Township 24 South, Range 29 East	845 PSIG
This well located in Eddy County, New Mexico.	

The Division Director may rescind this injection pressure increase if it becomes apparent that the injected water is not being confined to the injection zone or is endangering any fresh water aquifers.
