Reference is made to your request dated October 20, 1988, to increase the surface injection pressure on three wells within the North Vacuum Abo Unit Waterflood Project. This request is based on step rate tests conducted on these wells on October 5, 1988. The results of the tests have been reviewed by my staff and we feel an increase in injection pressure on these wells is justified at this time.


You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following wells.

NVAU Well No. 209 Unit J, Section 22, T-17S, R-34E	3816 PSIG
NVAU Well No. 302 Unit J, Section 3, T-17S, R-34E	3920 PSIG

All in Lea County, New Mexico.

The Division Director may rescind this injection pressure increase if it becomes apparent that the injected water is not being confined to the injection zone or is endangering any fresh water aquifers.
