Dear Mr. Murphy:

Reference is made to your request dated June 22, 1989, to increase the surface injection pressure on two wells within the Todd Lower San Andres Unit Waterflood Project. This request is based on step rate tests conducted on these wells on May 13, 1989. The results of the tests have been reviewed by my staff and we feel an increase in injection pressure on these wells is justified at this time.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following wells.



Both in Roosevelt County, New Mexico.

The Division Director may rescind this injection pressure increase if it becomes apparent that the injected water is not being confined to the injection zone or is endangering any fresh water aquifers.
