Reference is made to your request dated December 8, 1993 to increase the surface injection pressure on the above-referened well. This request is based on a step rate test conducted on these wells on November 15, 1993. The results of the test have been reviewed by my staff and we feel an increase in injection pressure on this well is justified at this time.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following well:
