ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-1638, The British-American Oil Producing Company, has made application to the Commission on February 25, 1963, for permission to expand its West Bisti Pressure Maintenance Project in the Bisti-Lower Gallup Oil Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 15th day of March, 1963, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That waivers of objection have been received from all offset operators.
4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-1638.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced pressure maintenance project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, The British-American Oil Producing Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Lower Gallup formation by the conversion to water injection of its West Bisti Unit Well No. 60, located in the NW/4 NE/4 of Section 30, Township 26 North, Range 13 West, San Juan County, New Mexico. Injection shall be down tubing under a packer and shall be through perforations from 5306 feet to 5331 feet.
