ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order R-2210, The Atlantic Refining Company has made application to the Commission on March 6, 1963, for permission to expand its Horseshoe-Gallup Pressure Maintenance Project in the Horseshoe-Gallup Oil Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 6th day of March, 1963, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified; of the application.
3. That waivers of objection have been received by offsetting operators and the waiting period as prescribed by Order R-2210 may be dispensed with at this time.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order R-2210.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced Pressure Maintenance project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, The Atlantic Refining Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Gallup formation through the following described wells for purposes of Pressure Maintenance, to wit:

Unit Well No. 143 located in the NE/4 SW/4 Section 21 and Unit Well No. 145 located in the SW/4 SE/4 of Section 21, both in Township 31 North, Range 16 West, NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall inject water through tubing with packers set at 1580 feet and 1604 feet, respectively, in the production casing of said wells.
