ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order R-2405, International Oil & Gas Company has made application to the Commission on August 23, 1963, for permission to expand its Pressure Maintenance Project in the East Millman Queen-Grayburg Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 29th day of August, 1963, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.

2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.

3. That no objection has been received by offsetting operators.

4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order R-2405.

5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced Pressure Maintenance project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, International Oil & Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Queen-Grayburg formation through the following described well for purposes of Pressure Maintenance, to wit:

State 648 Well No. 190 located in the SW/4 NE/4 of Section 15, Township 19 South, Range 28 East, NMPM.
