ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-2154, Humble Oil & Refining Company has made application to the Commission on February ¹⁴, 1964, for permission to expand its Northwest Cha Cha-Gallup Pressure Maintenance Project in the Cha Cha-Gallup Oil Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 5th day of March, 1964, the Secretary-Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed in due form.
- 2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
- 3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-2154.
- 4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-2154.
- 5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced pressure maintenance project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
 - 6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Humble Oil & Refining Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Gallup formation through the following described wells for purposes of Pressure Maintenance, to wit:

Northwest Cha Cha Unit Well No. 34-16 located in the SW/4 SE/4 of Section 16, El Paso Natural Gas Products Company Brimhall Well No. 1 located in the NE/4 SE/4 of Section 17, both in Township 29 North, Range 14 West, NMPM.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That the project area is hereby expanded to include: Section 17; that portion of the West Half (W/2) lying North of the mid-channel of the San Juan River and that portion of the Southeast Quarter (SE/4) lying North of the mid-channel of the San Juan River, and Section 16; S/2 NW/4 and that portion of the Southwest Ouarter (SW/4)

lying North of the Mid-channel of the San Juan River and that portion of the North Half of the Southeast Quarter (N/2 SE/4) lying North of the mid-channel of the San Juan River.
