NOW, on this 10th day of March, 1966, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-2210.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-2210.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced pressure maintenance project will not cause waste nor impair relative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


That the applicant, The Atlantic Refining Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Gallup formation through the following-described wells for purposes of pressure maintenance, to wit:

Unit Well No. 5 located in the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 30,  
and Unit Well No. 7 located in the SE/4 NW/4 of Section  
30, both in Township 31 North, Range 16 West, NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That the applicant shall inject water through tubing with packers set well below the top of the cement surrounding the 5 1/2-inch casing in said wells.
