ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-2026, Pan American Petroleum Corporation has made application to the Commission on April 25, 1966, for permission to expand its Northeast Hogback Unit Pressure Maintenance Project in the Horseshow-Gallup Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 15th day of May, 1966, the Secretary-Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed in due form.
- 2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
- 3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-2026.
- 4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-2026.
- 5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced pressure maintenance project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
 - 6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Pan American Petroleum Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Gallup formation through the following described well for purposes of pressure maintenance, to wit:

Unit Well No. 36 located in the SW/4 SE/4 of Section 10, Township 30 North, Range 16 West, NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall inject water through tubing with a packer set at approximately 1600 feet in the 5½-inch casing in said well.
