ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-2154, Humble Oil & Refining Company has made application to the Commission on April 11, 1968, for permission to expand its Northwest Cha Cha-Gallup Pressure Maintenance Project in the Cha Cha-Gallup Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 1st day of May, 1968, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-2154.
4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-2154.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced pressure maintenance project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


That the applicant, Humble Oil & Refining Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Gallup formation through the following-described well for purposes of pressure maintenance, to wit:

Northwest Cha Cha Unit Well No. 12, located in Unit E of Section 22, Township 29 North, Range 14 West, NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall inject water through tubing with a packer set at approximately 4800 feet in said well.

DONE at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year hereinabove designated.
