## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-4549, Atlantic Richfield Company has made application to the Commission on May 16th, 1974, for permission to expand its Arco Empire-Abo Unit Pressure Maintenance Project in the Empire-Abo Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 5th day of June, 1974, the Secretary-Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed in due form.
- 2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
- 3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-4549.
- 4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-4549.
- 5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
  - 6. That the application should be approved.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Atlantic Richfield Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Abo formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Empire Abo Unit B Well No. 49, located in Unit E of Section 29, Empire Abo Unit C Well No. 49, located in Unit L of Section 29, Empire Abo Unit C Well No. 50, located in Unit K of Section 29, all in Township 17 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.
